<p><b>Top</b></p> <p>Eye protection must provide protection across the brow. Significant gaps offer the potential for droplets to enter the eyes</p>						
<p><b>Side</b></p> <p>Full peripheral eye protection is required.</p>						

<p><b>Front</b></p> <p>Eyewear that extends down or provides a seal. Offers better protection.</p> <p>Safety glasses are intended for impact resistance rather than splash resistance</p>						
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**\*\* Face shields or Goggles are required for confirmed or suspected COVID patients. SafeView glasses are NOT acceptable for confirmed or suspected COVID patients.**
