COVID-19 test result is <b>negative</b>, follow steps #2-4            COVID-19 test result is <b>positive</b>, follow steps # 5-7</p> <p>If the patient tested <b>positive</b> for COVID-19 or was <b>presumed</b> to have COVID-19 by a provider and per the provider the infection has now cleared, follow step #8.</p>		Lab
2.	Lab Call Center notifies nursing of negative COVID-19 result.	EPIC automatically removes the "COVID-19 R/O" Infection	Lab
3.	RN notifies provider of negative result.		Nursing
4.	<p>RN asks provider if isolation can be discontinued.</p> <p><u>If isolation can be discontinued:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>RN to <a href="#">Remove</a> isolation and documents in the comment section - "Severe Respiratory Precautions discontinued due to negative COVID-19 test" (.NSEVERE).</li> <li>RN removes Severe Respiratory Precautions sign from the patient door and alerts Hot Zone Boss.</li> </ol> <p><u>If isolation should remain:</u>            RN to click <a href="#">Severe Respiratory</a> in the isolation status and document in the comment section</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>"Severe Respiratory Precautions to continue due to provider determination of high risk for COVID-19 infection" (.PSEVERE)</li> </ul>	Dot phrase can help with consistent documentation	Nursing
5.	Lab Call Center notifies RN of <b>positive</b> COVID-19 result.		Lab
6.	RN notifies provider of <b>positive</b> result.	EPIC auto changes the infection from "COVID-19 R/O" to "COVID-19 Confirmed"	

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7.	RN to click in <a href="#">Severe Respiratory</a> the isolation status and document in the comment section <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>“Severe Respiratory Precautions to continue for positive COVID-19 infection” (.YSEVERE)</li> </ul>	Dot phrase can help with consistent documentation	Nursing
8.	If infection has resolved and isolation can be discontinued: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>RN to <a href="#">Remove</a> the isolation and document in the comment section - “Severe Respiratory Precautions discontinued based on clinical discontinuation criteria per provider” (.CSEVERE).</li> <li>RN removes Severe Respiratory Precautions sign from the patient door and alerts Hot Zone Boss.</li> </ol>	Dot phrase can help with consistent documentation	Nursing
