1.	Lab enters result of COVID-19 testing into EPIC.		Lab
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test result is negative, <u>follow steps #2-3</u> COVID-19 test result is positive, <u>follow steps # 4-6</u> If the patient previously tested positive for COVID-19 or was presumed to have COVID-19 by a provider and there is now a request to discontinue the isolation, <u>follow step #7.</u> After 28 days, EPIC will auto resolve the INFECTION for outpatients. Infection Prevention regularly reviews the Isolation list and contacts Nursing and the Provider to determine if ISOLATION can be discontinued. 			
2.	Lab Call Center notifies nursing of negative COVID-19 result for inpatients. (Notification about ED patients is for positives only).	EPIC automatically removes the "COVID-19 R/O" Infection	Lab
3.	<p>RN asks provider if isolation can be discontinued.</p> <p><u>If isolation can be discontinued:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> RN to Remove isolation in Patient Isolation Status section in Epic. RN removes Severe Respiratory Precautions (SRP) sign from the patient door. <p><u>If isolation should remain:</u></p> <p>RN to click Severe Respiratory in the isolation status and document in the comment section:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> "Severe Respiratory Precautions to continue due to provider determination of high risk for COVID-19 infection" (.PSEVERE) 	<p>Dot phrase in the comment section can help with consistent documentation.-"Severe Respiratory Precautions discontinued due to negative COVID-19 test" (.NSEVERE).</p> <p>Use dot phrase .PSEVERE</p>	Nursing

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4.	Lab Call Center notifies RN of positive COVID-19 result.	EPIC auto changes the infection from "COVID-19 R/O" to "COVID-19 Confirmed"	Lab
5.	RN notifies provider of positive result.		Nursing
6.	RN to ensure SRP has been documented in the isolation status.	Dot phrase in the comment section can help with consistent documentation.-"Severe Respiratory Precautions to continue for positive COVID-19 infection" (.YSEVERE)	Nursing
7.	<p>To document removal of isolation for a patient who previously tested positive for COVID-19 or was presumed to have COVID-19 by a provider and there is now a request to discontinue the isolation :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> RN to contact the provider to confirm the Severe Respiratory Precautions can be discontinued. If provider has continued concern that requires SRP, then continue those precautions and document according to step #3. If no continued concern then go to b. RN contacts Infection Prevention by PerfectServe or phone to confirm criteria are met to remove the INFECTION. Infection Prevention resolves the INFECTION if criteria are met. (If criteria are not met, IP will document the reason in Epic). RN to Remove ⚡ solution in Patient Isolation Status section in Epic.
