RN to Remove isolation and documents in the comment section - "Severe Respiratory Precautions discontinued due to negative COVID-19 test" (.NSEVERE).</p> <p>b. RN removes Severe Respiratory Precautions sign from the patient door and alerts Hot Zone Boss.</p> <p><u>If isolation should remain:</u> RN to click Severe Respiratory in the isolation status and document in the comment section</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> "Severe Respiratory Precautions to continue due to provider determination of high risk for COVID-19 infection" (.PSEVERE) 	Dot phrase can help with consistent documentation	Nursing

RN to Remove the isolation and document in the comment section - "Severe Respiratory Precautions discontinued based on clinical discontinuation criteria per provider" (.CSEVERE). b. RN removes Severe Respiratory Precautions sign from the patient door and alerts Hot Zone Boss. 	Dot phrase can help with consistent documentation	Nursing
