1 - Pediatric Skills: can be an tailored (by resident) to focus on the needs for that individual (PICU, NICU or EM)

2 – Leadership: we strongly encourage a leadership block in the PICU or NICU. Other options include hospitalist leadership or resident as teacher

3 – Advanced Subspecialty: please discuss with chiefs as goal is a wide variety of electives – may be able to convert to primary elective experience

4 - Electives:
